DISTRICT GOVERNOR

The District Governor leads the District Council (DC), sets the agenda for District goals and objectives, and is the liaison to the Rotary District. The District Governor leads monthly meetings with District Council. The District Governor represents the Interact District at all official Rotary events and is responsible for organizing district-wide Interact training events. The District Governor works with the Rotary District Interact Chair and keeps the Rotary Advisor Council apprised of the events and activities of the District Council.

LIEUTENANT GOVERNOR

The Lieutenant Governor supports the District Governor in carrying out the activities of the District Council. The Lieutenant Governor substitutes for the District Governor as needed and is qualified and prepared to assume the role of the District Governor. The Lieutenant Governor will oversee such District Council events, activities, or committees as requested by the District Governor.

- be a senior or junior during the 2010-2011 school year
- attended at least one DC meeting
- attend a Gov/Lt. Gov Training Workshop on March 20th
- attend at least one FLC, PWR, and Spring Sendoff
- served as Interact club officer
- has permission from parent/guardian to serve
- is in good standing with school
- can attend overnight events

- hold a valid California Drivers License
